Vineyards: Stonetree and Double River Ranch

Grapes: 100% Tempranillo

Vintage Season: warm and dry, rapid ripening season, yields near average

Barrels: 23 months in American Oak, 30% new

Time in Cellar: bottled July 2009

Aroma: smokey black cherry with savory herb, hints of vanilla and rose petal

Taste: effusive ripe and persistent fruit, sweet spice and smooth finish

Alcohol: 13.8%

Lot size: 258 cases

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

---

The grapes for our Tempranillo come from two distinct sites: Stonetree is planted to a south facing, gravelly slope near Mattawa on the Wahluke Slope, and Double River Ranch lies in the Walla Walla Valley on a steep, south facing hillside with deep silty soils. Both are among the oldest Tempranillo plantings in the northwest. Shows dark cherry fruit with hints of vanillin, smoke, and rose petal. Medium bodied, ripe style showing sweet fruit by mouth, mild tannins, and a clean, persistent fruit finish.
