average yields.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Deep red-purple color. Intense aroma of black fruits, sweet spice and vanilla. Generous, mouth-filling ripe fruit palate, surrounded by spicy oak notes and a soft, accessible structure. Lengthy, smooth fruit-spice finish. This is an exciting, exuberant red wine blend that shouts out "Delicious!" Styled to drink well at release, and will be enjoyable for a couple of years in cellar. But, why wait?
