**WINEMAKER'S NOTES**

---

Full dark red color. Explosive nose of ripe red plum jam, blackberry, vanillin and sweet spice. Effusive, jammy palate of sweet red and black fruits, smooth tannins on a balanced structure. Persistent fruit finish with pleasing dry, polished tannin background. One of the most exuberant Cabernet Sauvignons the old block at Seven Hills has ever produced. Should age well for six to eight years.
