WINEMAKER'S NOTES

100% Malbec, hand-selected from Windrow, Minnick and McClellan Estate Vineyards, three hillside sites in the Walla Walla Valley appellation. Harvest conditions were ideal. Assertive scent of passion fruit and blueberry, with floral and spice notes. Medium weight body with moderate tannin. Berry finish and slightly drying. Barrel aged in fine Hungarian Oak to accentuate aromatics and compliment the silky mouth feel of the wine. This wine shows qualities that indicate at least three to four years of enjoyable cellar life.
